

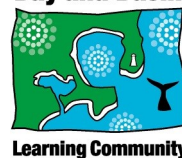

Upgrades at Plantation Point Reserve

Shoalhaven City Council has received funding under the NSW Government's Stronger Country Communities Fund for upgrades to the playground, amenities and beach access at Plantation Point Reserve, Vincentia.

The upgrades include:

- a new playground that is inclusive to all ages and abilities
- a new amenities building with provisions for persons with a disability
- a mural on the external surface of the amenities
- accessible beach access from the reserve to Barfleur Beach.

The current funding will allow for the staged development of new play equipment. With community support and encouragement, if the council were to input additional funding, a more suitable playground that meets the needs of the growing community would be a possibility, like the one featured below.
